Description

A very high quality mantel clock dating to the mid Victorian period. It has a solid oak rectangular case, a brass bezel with a thick bevel edge glass and a white enamel dial, which is signed by Charles Frodsham, Clockmaker to The Queen.

It has a fine 8 day French made movement that strikes the hours and halves on a bell and is signed on the backplate and numbered 24626. It has its original pendulum which is also numbered 24626. The inside of the case is also finished and polished. The clock comes with its period key and a set up and instruction video if required.
